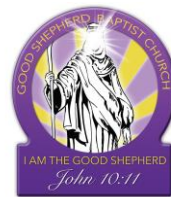

Wisdom Of The Week

Watch Where You Are Going Proverbs 4:23-27

Maybe it was our parents or maybe it was a sibling or maybe it was a friend who warned us to *'Watch Where We Were Going'*. Here in Proverbs 4, we are told to guard our heart.

The heart should be guarded for out of it come one's actions. Here the word "heart" means more than mental or emotional capacity; it refers to one's values

If we read these verses carefully, we will discover that Solomon is saying that guarding one's heart includes:

- What we say (verse 24)
- What we see (verse 25)
- And what we do (verses 26-27)

Path and ways in verse 26 refers to our conduct.

Saints who are watching where they are going are like the alert driver.

The alert driver keeps his or her eyes on the road. They may look around at the scenery but are not distracted by it.

The major theme in the Book of Proverbs is wisdom.

Wisdom will keep you alert to where you are going and keep you on the right path. So, my prayer for us is; Lord, help us to **"Watch Where We Are Going."**
