### Wisdom Of the Week What A Holy Life Says

*Acts 11:26 and it came to pass, that a whole year they assembled themselves with the church, and taught much people. And the disciples were **called Christians first** in Antioch.*

Here in this text, we see that the lives of these believing men and women in Antioch were so different that others began to call them “Christians”, the literal translation is “Little Christs”.

Good Shepherd, people who look at the life we live, will they say “**we are little Christs**”.

Saints, nothing preaches louder than a holy life – unless it is an unholy life. Then the message is drowned out by the sinful life of the messenger.

The unholy life of a saint, or to put it in simple terms, the saints who is living in sin, says to the unbelieving world “we are one of the gang”; we one of you”.

Saints, if we want the world to see “little Christs”, we must do what the Scripture says in **2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them (the world), and be ye separate, saith the Lord....”**
