1 Chronicles 29:14 But, who am I, and what is my people, that we should be able to offer so willingly after this sort? for "all" things come of thee, and of thine own have we given thee.

The truths in the previous verses, **verses 12-14**, should drive every saint of God to his or her knees in thanksgiving. David is acknowledging God as the ONE who is able and, indeed has supplied the people's needs.
